

SCC Faculty Meeting Minutes

January 23, 2009

Chair called the meeting to order.

Minutes of November meeting were distributed. Motion was made and seconded. Minutes approved.

The Resolution for continued health care for retired teachers and the continuance of tenure was presented. Members completed survey. Majority of faculty favored endorsing the resolution. (Unofficial count at close of meeting was 72 in favor, 4 voted against endorsing resolution and 1 abstention.)

Dr. Marshall stated the state budget reduction was reduced from the proposed 4% to a proposed 2%.

Dr. Honeycutt said that we have had a 3.6% increase in students based on the numbers from this time last year. We have had an 11% increase in on-line students. There are 59% of SCC students taking on-line classes, total, and 50% are taking courses with us at SCC.

Jon Burlew made an announcement concerning the General Education workshop meeting in Versailles and asked for input via email.

Lynn Shearer made an announcement about the African-American Read-In Chain, which will be held in the Rogers Community Room on Sunday, February 1, at 3:00. Everyone is invited to attend.

Kim Cleberg made an announcement on behalf of Barb Hall concerning the custodial card user agreements. All personnel must have this form on file before they can use a procard.

Alice Grover moved to adjourn, second by Lynn Shearer.
